

# Screen Auckland COVID-19 Protection Framework Guidelines for Filming in Tāmaki Makaurau

All filming activity must be conducted in accordance with the COVID-19 Protection Framework (CPF) and ScreenSafe Covid-19 Health and Safety Protocols. Screen Auckland cannot accept film permit applications that do not meet these requirements.

Film permits will be issued in accordance with the COVID-19 Protection Framework (CPF) and ScreenSafe COVID-19 Health and Safety Protocols in place on the day of issuance. If there is a change in the CPF setting or requirements that will affect the filming activity, the permit may be amended or rescinded.

# **Location Access**

#### Access to Auckland Council owned or managed locations for commercial or organised activities is permitted

Filming activity that complies with the CPF and ScreenSafe Covid-19 Health and Safety Protocols can be considered in the following public open spaces:

- Local parks, reserves and beaches
- Regional Parks
- Roads and footpaths
- Council venues and facilities
- Tūpuna Maunga

#### **Film Permit Application Requirements**

#### Permits are required for ALL filming activities

Applications for MAJOR, HIGH, MEDIUM, LOW impact activities must include:

- Acknowledgement that production complies with the CPF and ScreenSafe Covid-19 Health and Safety Protocols
- Detailed Sitemap
- Site-specific JSA with COVID-19 controls and named COVID-19 officer
- Public Liability Insurance Certificate (\$5 million minimum)
- Screen Auckland COVID-19 letterbox drop / notification (location dependent)

#### **Screen Auckland COVID-19 Permit Controls & Conditions**

All productions must be **registered with ScreenSafe** and comply with the CPF and ScreenSafe COVID-19 Health and Safety Protocols. For full details on protocols and requirements visit **ScreenSafe**.

- All activities must have a designated, competent COVID-19 officer on location for the duration of the filming activity. This person must have experience and in-depth knowledge of COVID-19 protocols

- Health and Safety Plan with COVID-19 controls, named COVID-19 officer, and site-specific JSA Public Liability Insurance Certificate (\$5 million
- minimum)
- Screen Auckland COVID-19 letterbox drop / notification (location dependent)

#### Screen Auckland COVID-19 Permit Controls & Conditions

All productions must be registered with ScreenSafe and comply with the CPF and ScreenSafe COVID-19 Health and Safety protocols. For full details on protocols and requirements visit **ScreenSafe**.

Key requirements include:

- All activities must have a designated, competent COVID-19 officer on location for the duration of the filming activity. This person must have experience and in-depth knowledge of COVID-19 protocols
- Use of **engineering controls** to manage filming locations (e.g., physical barriers)
- Display appropriate posters/signage in the appropriate areas around the site
- There is No GOVT Requirement to Use QR Codes or to Contact Trace. Productions are encouraged to have contact tracing measures in place to prevent a wider production outbreak.
- Physical distancing of 1 metre is recommended between crew within worksite and 2 metres from members of the
- Remember **mask use is mandatory** in certain settings under red.
- Enhanced cleaning of the work site is to be undertaken. Additional facilities maybe required for larger personnel numbers, i.e., portaloo(s)
